

Visitation Rules

Once you arrive to the facility you will FIRST go to the daycare center as it is strongly suggested that you be tested for COVID-19 each and every time you visit. The nurse will only provide a test for those who are 18 years of age and older. NO ONE UNDER 18 YEARS of age will be permitted to visit. You will be checked for signs and symptoms of COVID-19. Visitation will be refused if anyone exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms, tests positive, or does not pass the screening questions.

- You must bring your working cell phone and provide the number to the screener, so that we may call you after you have been tested. You will receive notice of the results (Must be negative) and then be able to enter the building. You MUST wear a well fitted N95 and a surgical face mask, goggles that we provide at all times!!!!
- If YOU AND YOUR loved one is fully vaccinated (2 WEEKS AFTER SECOND DOSE), you can choose to have close contact (including touch) BUT YOU MUST BE WEARING A WELL FITTED N95 FACEMASK AT ALL TIMES. No Exceptions even while in your loved one's room.
- You and your guest must be the ones signed up for the scheduled visit. No exceptions!!!!
- Visiting hours are by appointment only and will be held Monday through Friday from 10:00am-5pm and on weekends from 11am-5pm. If you are not vaccinated please call your social worker to sign up for a visit.
- Visitation will last 30 minutes (UNVACCINATED) in duration so that other family members are able to have the same privilege to visit their loved one. Please be on time, as your end time will not change, thus leading to a shorter visit.
- If you and your loved one are FULLY VACCINATED and are on the units you may NOT ATTEND any social activities. In room or outside only!!!!
- All visiting stations will be sanitized after each visit to ensure the safety and wellbeing for both residents and family members after each visit.
- If you are vaccinated you will be allowed to take your loved one outside in the courtyard or by the front entrance (NO wandering throughout building). For those who are not vaccinated you must remain at the designated visitation stations in the lobby.
- Residents will be allowed to have no more than 2 visitors per day!!!!. Multiple sign ups in one day will be deleted and you will be notified via email!!! No pets allowed at this time!!!!
- Compassionate visits can be offered on a case by case basis and will be reviewed by your Inter-Disciplinary-Team.
- Photo and video use during your visit is strictly prohibited. Please respect the privacy of others during your social visit
- *Visitors must maintain social distancing(6ft) during their visit unless your loved one is fully vaccinated. There will be no food or drinks allowed while visiting your loved one. There cannot be any physical contact with other residents, families, or staff.*
- Failure to comply with any of these guidelines will result in immediate termination of the visit and you will be asked to leave the facility.
- PLEASE NOTE: In the event of any circumstances that are beyond our control, we will contact you by phone to reschedule your visit.
- If you are NOT VACCINATED, please use the bathroom prior to your visit as the bathrooms will not be accessible during your visit.
- These guidelines are subject to contradictory guidance from CMS, DOH, or other regulatory agencies.
